

# Benchmarking and farm reports in Flanders

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## Why benchmark?

#### Motivate farmers:

Comparing themselves with similar activities is one of the biggest motivators

#### Validate your results:

- → Population comparison
  - $\rightarrow$  Visually
  - $\rightarrow$  Outlier controls
- → An interested farmer who understands the results will provide a good crosscheck

## Types of benchmarking?

- Internal data vs external data
- Digital: interactive
- Competitive feedback: positioning
- ▶ Strategic feedback:
   → Fatten or sell cattle?
  - $\rightarrow$  Higher cost = higher reward?
- Time lapse:  $\rightarrow$  Evolution



## How to benchmark with impact?

- Ongoing search for best practises ...
- Automated quality checks based on population outliers.
- Automated quality checks based on benchmarking with previous year.
- For users reports: keep it simple:
  - $\rightarrow$  Quick scan
  - → High level visualisation: spotting divergence
  - → Visual: only deep dive in case of divergence
  - → Checks: only mark divergence

# $\rightarrow$ Continuous search for report that can entice first users and satisfy accomplished users

## Benchmarking bottlenecks

- On what level <u>can</u> you benchmark?
  - $\rightarrow$  Farm level
  - $\rightarrow$  Farm activity level
  - → Previous data

### • How to define your population?!

- $\rightarrow$  Defining 'similar activities'
- → Too much detail => to small a population for stat. analysis for ex. strawberries – glass cover – heated – substrate – June bearer
- -> Too high level => what are you comparing?

### • How to build a steady population?

- $\rightarrow$  Remove outliers: for ex. organic, small area, to little cattle, ...
- $\rightarrow$  Weighing of farms: specialized farms have more impact ong

  - → FARMANALYSIS REPORT (ire)
    - $\times$  All activities
    - × High level  $\rightarrow$  deep dive
    - $\times$  AVG + ranking (p25 p75)
  - $\rightarrow$  FARM ACCOUNTANCY REPORT (SAS EG pdf format)
    - × Farm structure
    - × Financial data
    - × Farm income
    - × Assets and liabilities (loans, investment, plots,...)
    - $\times$  Result on farm level and per farm activity
    - × Population avg

#### → Highest detailed report

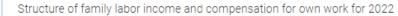

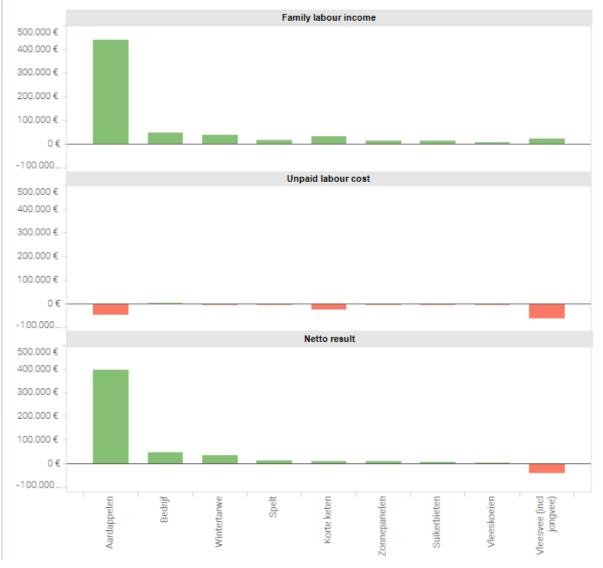

    - $\times$  Self-comparison: timeline
    - × Population deviation: high level
    - $\times$  AVG + ranking (p25 p75)
  - $\rightarrow$  FARM ACCOUNTANCY REPORT (SAS EG pdf format)
    - $\times$  High detail
    - × Bank

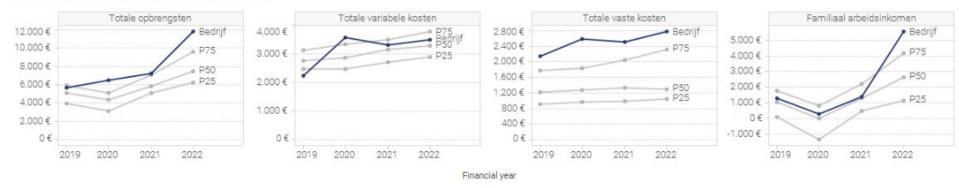

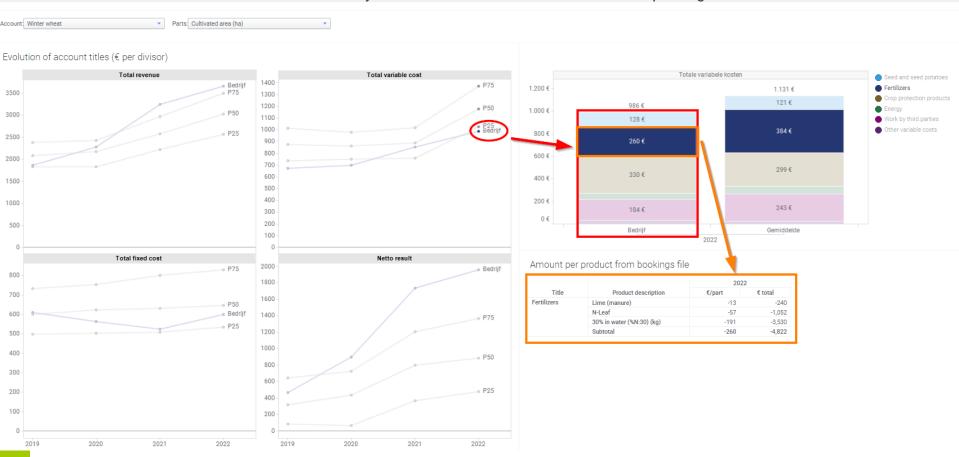

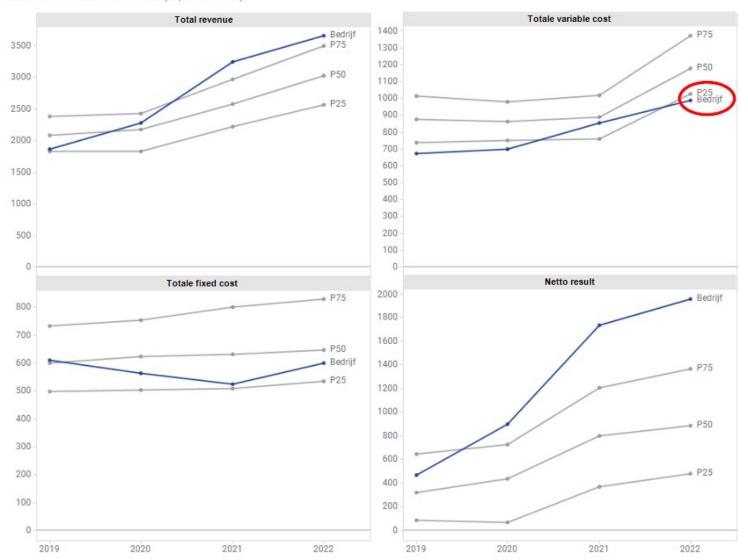

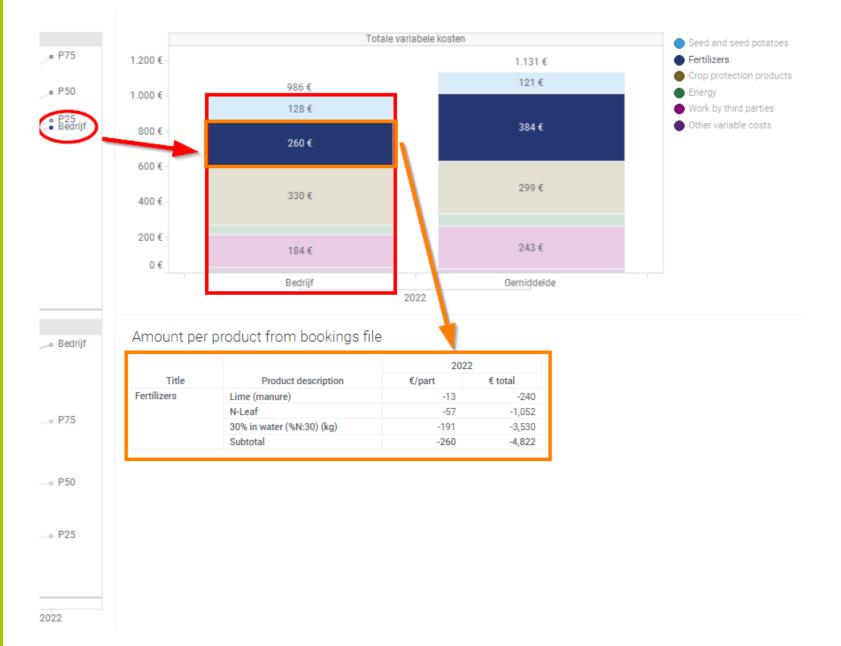
Account: Winter wheat
